Normally Performed Duties

- Flag and direct traffic as required while crews work in roadways requiring traffic protection

- Assist in installing water services
- Assist in installing water mains
- Assist in the maintenance of equipment and vehicles
- Assist in flushing water fire hydrants and other devices
- Assist in repairing or replacing water valves
- Assist in work zone cleanup
- Assist in yard repairs after excavations
- Assist in road repair after excavations
- Learn and assist in locating underground utilities using a variety of methods to accurately determine locations
